## <u>The winder</u>

Difficulty: \*\* Preparation: \*

for this trick, you will need Z identical coins and your winder. You can use Z small and identical objects of your choice, compatible with the winder's clip (sheets of paper, identical rings, erasers...)

Place one of the Z coins in your pocket "the traveling coin".

Attach the winder to your pants and hide it with your shirt or t-shirt. Pull on the thread and pinch the second coin, hiding the clip with your hand.

Pretend to put the coin in your left hand. At the same time, release the coin and close your left fist.

All you need to do is explain that the coin has traveled by pulling the "traveling coin" out of your pocket.

(for the experts, before your show, place the "traveling coin" discreetly in the pocket of a spectator without them noticing, of course. You can introduce the "traveling coin" discreetly into the pocket of the spectator by asking them to move around with one hand on their upper back while the other hand discreetly slips the coin into one of their pockets. For the reveal, once you have removed the other coin from the clip, ask the "victim spectator" to look for the coin that has traveled in their pocket.

Tip: to avoid the noise of the clip hitting the winder and to be more discreet on stage, even if the trick works fine without this tip, I cut a cardboard straw about 3 cm long, make a groove along the whole length to insert the wire and wrap it with tape.
